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Cultural Activity Pack for Schools #1: Afghanistan





Afghanistan is a land-locked country in the centre of Asia. It borders 6 countries: Pakistan, Iran, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and China.

Afghanistan has a population of 40.2 million and it covers over 251,000 square miles of land, making it a little bit bigger than France.

Afghanistan's capital city is called Kabul and is found in the East. It's main languages are Pashto and Dari. Over 99% of the country are Muslim. It's currency is called the Afghani.

Afghanistan has lots of mountain ranges and flat land called plateaus. The countries highest point is Noshaq, which is 7492 metres above sea level - that's the same as 23 Eiffel Towers stacked on top of each other. Although Afghanistan is a very dry country with incredibly hot summers, in the winter it receives lots of snow in its mountains.

Afghanistan's flag is black, red and green and at its centre is the national emblem which includes a picture of a mosque, two flags and an Arabic inscription.

Afghanistan's national animal is the snow leopard, the golden eagle is its national bird and the tulip is its national flower.





United Kingdom



Pound Sterling (£) GBP



The currency of the UK is called the Pound Sterling.

A one pound coin has a silver looking centre with a gold border.

Afghanistan



The currency of Afghanistan is called the Afghani.

A one Afghani coin is circular and is made of copper plated steel - the same as 1p and 2p coins here in the UK.

Afghani Coins

On 11 April 2005, Afghani coins were introduced in denominations of 1, 2 and 5 Afghanis.





Value




In March 2022, **£1** (GBP) was worth the same as **4116** (AFN).

In the UK, **£1 = 100 pennies**.

In Afghanistan, **à 1 = 100 puls**.

However, pul coins are no longer in circulation and the \$1 coin is now the smallest value coin you can use.









3D KITE DESIGN

Kite-flying is one of Afghanistan's national sports. Follow the instructions to make your own 3D kite design.


Step 1

Fold a square piece of paper in half diagonally, then unfold it to create a crease.




Step 2

Fold the bottom-left corner to meet the crease.




Step 3

Repeat Step 2 on the top-right corner.



Step 4

Turn the whole sheet of paper over to see your kite sail.




Step 5

Apply some glue to the <u>back</u> of your kite sail. Step 6 Stick the back of your kite onto a new sheet of paper.


Step 7

Use a pen to draw the kite string.



Step 8

<u>Carefully</u> cut out the clouds from the **Cloud Template** – ask an adult to help you.






<u>Carefully</u> cut out strips of paper using the template - ask an adult to help you.

Fold your strips in half to create the ribbons for your kite string.






Step 10

Stick the clouds and ribbons onto your design.







Step 11


One thing that stands out to us all when working at bridging hotels is the number of children who had to leave behind their homes, their friends and their schools, to move thousands of miles to the other side of the world. It was this that gave us the idea of producing an activity pack that could be used in schools to both educate children about Afghanistan but also to give Afghan children an opportunity to showcase to their peers the country they have left and a day to feel proud about where they have come from.

The activity pack is made up of 17 different activities, all of which have been designed by the Bridge to Unity team, with direct input from individuals from Afghanistan, as well as teaching professionals. It was important to us that we received input from both those from Afghanistan and from teachers themselves, to ensure we produced a pack that was culturally appropriate and educational.

All the activities are aimed at primary school children aged between 4 and 11. You will notice some activities are better suited to older children and some to younger. We have provided this pack as an e-document to allow you, the teacher, to decide which activities are most suitable for your class.
